I will be on the gate each morning, so please take the opportunity to introduce yourselves. It may take a little while for me to remember everyone but I will try my best!

Please can all parents note the following;

- A member of staff will be on duty in the playground from 0845 and unaccompanied children **MUST** be left on the playground.
- Children with parents may wait at the lower area by the gate. Please can younger siblings wait here too?
- Children need to dismount from bikes and scooters before entering the school and then park them in the allocated spaces. Children may then collect them at the end of the day and ride them once they have left the school premises.
- The bell will ring at 0855 so that children are able to be in their classrooms and ready to start the school day at 0900 promptly.
- When the bell rings, the children are expected to **STOP** and listen for their class to be called.
- On wet mornings, the children will go straight to their classrooms.

Children arriving after 0900 should go directly to the office so that they can be signed in and taken to their classroom.
